Introduction to GSA 8(a) STARS II

GSA 8(a) STARS II is a multiple-award, indefinite delivery/ indefinite quantity (IDIQ) contract engineered to provide cutting-edge technology solutions from award-winning 8 (a) small businesses to federal agencies. Using GSA 8(a) STARS II will enable you to access 8(a) firms through an established contract vehicle instead of traditional, open market methods – saving time and taxpayer money.



Contract Scope

The scope of the 8(a) STARS II GWAC is centered on four functional areas (FAS) derived from the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS).

The contract offers simple to complex IT service solutions such as:

- Insider Threat**
- Agile Software Development**
- Network System Administration**
- Hardware Engineering**
- Cyber Security**

Ordering

Prior to issuing orders under GSA 8(a) STARS II, federal contracting officers are required to receive training on the use of the GSA 8(a) STARS II contract and be granted a written delegation of procurement authority from the GSA Small Business GWAC Center. Training is offered at no cost via:

- ⇒ **A self-paced, online course**
- ⇒ **Onsite training conferences and events**
- ⇒ **Web or video conferences**
- ⇒ **Conference calls.**
